### Role Summary

This role is intended for a Certified Flight Instructor with a strong academic aviation background who can serve as a subject matter expert for professional pilot training content. You will work closely with engineering and product teams to translate real world flight training knowledge into structured, system ready instructional content. This is a content development and training architecture role, not a flight instruction role.

- Translate flight training concepts into clear, modular instructional material suitable for digital delivery
- Define lesson objectives, training flows, and assessment concepts aligned with professional pilot training standards
- Collaborate with engineering and software teams to ensure training content aligns with system capabilities and constraints
- Review and refine training modules for technical accuracy, clarity, and consistency
- Help organize training content to support scalability, version control, and long-term curriculum growth
